Community Resources for Families (CRFF), as it's name suggests, connects families with appropriate resources available in the community. It is a voluntary preventionbased program developed to provide assis-

tance and support for families whose children attend participating schools. A wide range of service is available through CRFF but is specifically designed to assist a family facing crisis or in an emergency situation.

There are various ways in which a family can participate, depending upon their individual need and desire. The level of involvement can range from a one-time visit to obtain needed information to an assessment and planning process of up to 90 days. Since CRFF is a partnership between the School District and Idaho Department of Health and Welfare, financial assistance may be made available for those who qualify.
